Detailed Feedback by Skill

Listening

Band 8.0

Excellent grasp of detail and gist across all four sections. You handled distractors in Section 3 confidently and tracked the academic monologue in Section 4 with minimal slip. Two errors clustered on plural/singular endings — a mechanical, not comprehension, issue.

Reading

Band 7.5

Strong skimming and locating skills; matching-headings and T/F/NG accuracy is high. The remaining lift to Band 8 lies in paraphrase recognition for inference questions and in pacing — you spent ~25 min on Passage 3 versus the recommended 20.

Writing

Band 7.0

Task 2 shows a clear position and developed arguments with relevant examples. Cohesion is mostly natural. Lexical range reaches Band 7 but lacks the consistent precision of Band 8 (occasional collocational slips: *do* vs *make*, *economical* vs *economic*). Task 1 overview is present but underlined trends could be sharper.

Speaking

Band 7.5

Fluency is at Band 8 — you self-correct without losing the thread. Pronunciation is clear with effective sentence stress. Grammar holds at Band 7: complex structures appear but with occasional article and tense slips under pressure in Part 3 abstract questions.

Strengths Analysis

- Consistent listening accuracy under exam pressure — particularly in academic contexts.
- Clear written position with developed, on-topic arguments in Task 2.
- Confident spoken fluency with effective use of discourse markers (*having said that, broadly speaking*).
- Strong inference reading: you correctly handled 8 of 9 inference items.

Areas for Improvement

- **Writing lexis:** tighten word choice — replace overused items (*important, good*) with precise alternatives (*pivotal, compelling*).
- **Writing Task 1:** always include a one-sentence overview that names the two most striking trends before any detail.
- **Reading pacing:** cap each passage at 20 minutes; transfer answers as you go rather than at the end.
- **Speaking grammar:** drill article use (a/the/zero) and past perfect in Part 3 hypotheticals.
- **Listening spelling:** rehearse plural endings and numeric formats (dates, prices, phone numbers).
